Orientation Programme	<p>An Orientation Programme A five day-orientation programme for new incoming international students is arranged twice a year, at the beginning of each semester. During the academic year of 2002-2003, the autumn semester orientation will begin on Monday, September 2, 2002 and the spring semester orientation on Tuesday, January 7, 2003. More information is available at www.joensuu.fi/students. It is highly recommended for new students to participate in the orientation programme. If an exchange student's period of study at the University of Joensuu is shorter than one semester (for instance, three months only), it is recommended that the student arrive in Joensuu at the beginning of a semester, in order to be able to participate in the orientation and to optimise his/her study opportunities.</p>
Insurance	<p>University of Joensuu requires and assumes that all incoming international students have valid personal (travel) insurance from an internationally recognised insurance agency for the duration of their stay in Joensuu. This insurance should cover all costs related to treatment of sudden illnesses, accidents and accidental death. Students cannot register at the University of Joensuu unless they present proof of valid insurance upon arrival when registering at the Student Registry Office.</p>
